

Contract Provisions:

All business transactions will be concluded with a signed contract by the leader of the band and the employer. It's very important for the employer to return the contract signed within the time designated on the contract. Some of the more important provisions in the contract are:

Starting and Breaks - The employer and the band agree on this in the contract and if the band is tardy or fails to comply with the breaks, their pay shall be prorated and the incident shall be reported to The Agency, Ltd.

Dress Preference - The contract calls for the employer to specify the dress of the group and the band will comply. All the groups from The Agency, Ltd. will appear suitably attited for the occasion.

Guests - No guests with the band unless the group leader has written permission from the employer. If the groups do bring non-participating members, they will pay the regular admission charge.

Supervision - The employer shall at all times have complete supervision, direction and control of the services of the band. This includes drinking and smoking on stage while performing. Any violation of the contract rules shall be reported to The Agency, Ltd.

Signing of Contracts - All contracts have a void date which means the employer must sign the contract and return them as the date specifies.

Booking The Finest in Musical Entertainment is the goal of The Agency. Ltd. Work with your group when they arrive, discussing the breaks, type of music you want and what you expect of the band. They will work with you to the best of their ability and both of you will be pleased.
